

4th Grade Ohio Windows Project

The 4th grade teachers wanted to do a project focused on Ohio History, which was the Social Studies curriculum for the year. I worked with each of the 4th grade classes to develop an Ohio History theme for each window (each class worked collaboratively on their own window). Teachers provided books and on-line materials for student research during "project work times" during the week. I came in to supervise the development of initial idea sketches and final artwork, and provided materials. I had the glass removed from six old wooden window frames. Students helped paper mache, paint and decorate the frames in small groups with me in the hallway. I laminated the final art pieces and students decided on the layout of their windows. The windows were installed along a wall in the hallway near the 4th grade classrooms.

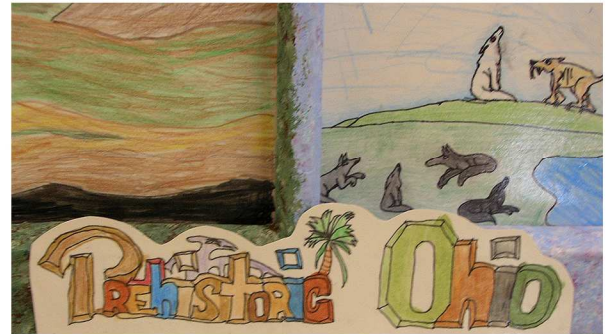
