

# Chinese Style Scroll Painting Workshop

A mixed group of students in grades 1-5 participated in two sessions of this workshop. Students began by looking at samples of Chinese paintings and discussing some basic elements of Chinese design and style. Four reference handouts were distributed to each table showing simple examples of flowers, trees, mountains, scenery, people, and architecture. Students composed their own designs lightly in pencil, inked in outline areas with permanent black markers, applied crayon to areas where they wanted intense color, and ended by applying water color washes to the background.
